The walk will be preceded by a launch of the Platypus Count program in the Cooma Region. Platypus Count is a volunteer based Platypus monitoring program which involves watching for Platypus from as little as 4 times a month. Volunteers who join the program receive a free platypus watching kit and t-shirt.
